- > Librarians involved in College Success curriculum development since the outset of the course
- > Fall 2015 43 sections of 3-credit College Success course with IC lesson taught by librarians = 1,000+ students
 - \circ ~ IC lesson refined over last two years, now includes pre-assignment and in-class exploration
- > 10 sections to date of 5-credit College Success course which integrates IC into curriculum
- > Librarians teach the 3- and 5-credit courses
