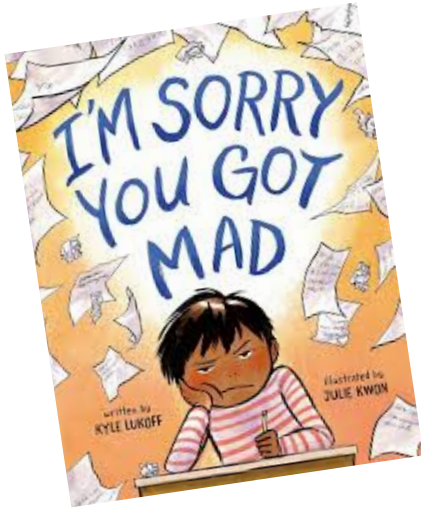


MISTAKES & REPAIR



As Jack learns in this story, an effective* repair **includes 3 parts**:

- 1) **ACKNOWLEDGE** what I did
- 2) share that I'm sorry (**APOLOGIZE**)
- 3) help fix it OR share what I will do next time (**ACT**)

**effective means it worked to make the other person feel better!*

PARTNER ACTIVITY: MAKE A COMIC!

A **conflict** is an **argument** or **disagreement**. Work with a partner to **discuss conflicts** that you've seen or experienced at school.

Together, **draw a comic to illustrate the conflict** and the **3 repair steps**. Use the panels on the back of this sheet, or extras if you need them.
