Suggested Reading Date: November 14th (the day that the eruption was first noted); April 7th (Geologist's Day); May (Washington State's Volcano Preparedness Month)

Activity Descriptions:

- Discuss the emotions and feelings that the two men might have felt at different points in the story.
- Share survival skills and how the two men could have been better prepared.
- Talk the author's decision to add in information about "the wishing moment" and the one untrue detail. Why do they think he chose to do that?
- Share the video below about how Iceland is using geothermal energy. Discuss reasons that they are doing that.
