## This is Not My Story By: Ryan Uytdewilligen Illustrated: David Huyck

**Synopsis:** This hilarious and unique take on metafiction offers a behind-the-scenes look at the creative process as the hero of this book embarks on a genre-bending journey to find the right story with the help of the author.

**Suggested Reading Date:** Beginning of the year/unit to introduce genre; April 27<sup>th</sup> (National Tell a Story Day); March 20 (World Storytelling Day)

## **Activity Descriptions:**

- Teach about genres and ask students to name the genres in the book.
- Have students discuss their favorite genre.
- Have students write the type of story they would like to be in.
- Create an interactive storytelling activity where students work together to create storyboards, write an alternate ending, or act out scenes from the book.
- Have students create the main character, aliens, or other characters with playdough, clay, or other materials.
- Discuss the different styles of illustrations and that the illustrator used a mix of narrative and graphic novel styles. Have students create their own related graphic novel/page.
