Why a gallery?

- A gallery beautifies a library
- Bring displays to people who may not visit a gallery or museum
- You have the space so why not?
- Promote, enhance, and participate in arts and culture in your community
- A chance for patrons to interact with artists and vice-versa
- Bring out hidden collections from your archives, museum storage, etc.
- Address social issues in the community
- Provide a place to display faculty and student art

What does it cost?

- Staff time!
- Costs vary depending on level of gallery can be very expensive or very inexpensive
- Budget may include furniture, hardware, display "props," printing costs, and more

Working with exhibitors

- Provide clear expectations, rules and dates in writing (see forms below for examples)
- Try to gauge the exhibitor's level of experience so you know how much you need to do
- Be ready for lots of hand-holding
- Anticipate questions/problems and have materials to address them

Selecting and planning exhibits

- Put out a "Call to artists"
- Consider reflecting cultural programming months (e.g. Native American Heritage Month, etc.)
- Highlight existing collections, such as archive or museum content
- Feature faculty, staff, and student art
